



## **REEL IDENTIFICATION**

Every reel of paper produced by **Aia Print** is identified by a standard marking system consisting of a label on the belly and ink-jet stencilling on the reel end.




# Ink-jet stencilling





## **BAR CODE REEL IDENTIFICATION**

The WAN IFRA barcode is made up of 16 digits.



#### Digits 1 to 8: Reel number

1: Paper machine number

2 y 3: Week of manufacture

4: Year of manufacture

5 to 8: Consecutive reel number

#### Digits 9 to 12:

Reel weight

#### Digit 13:

Copacking + Manufacturer code

Number of reels per pack (1, 2 or 3)

### Digit 14:

#### Grammage

1=40 g/m2 standard newsprint

2= 45 standard newsprint

**3**= 48.8 standard newsprint

**4**= 52 standard newsprint

**5**= Otros standard newsprint

6=45 g/m2 upgraded newsprint

7= 48.8 g/m2 upgraded newsprint

8= 52 g/m2 upgraded newsprint

9= 55 g/m2 upgraded newsprint

0= Otros upgraded newsprint

Manufacturer code: 2

#### Digit 16:

Manufacturer code: 6
